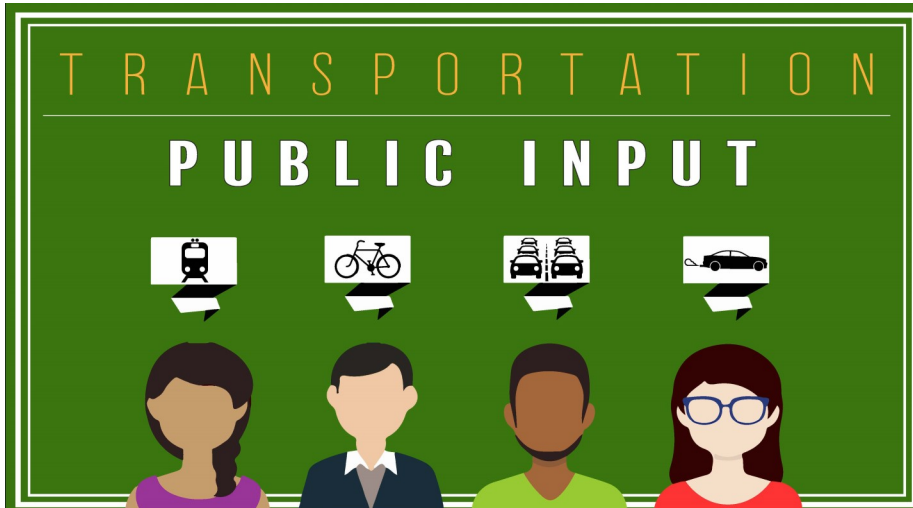

2020-2022 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Goals

As a recipient of federal transportation funds, NCTCOG is required to establish and periodically update DBE participation goals to encourage contracting opportunities for minority and historically underutilized businesses. The draft update of the DBE participation goals will be posted for review and comment.

Upcoming Unified Transportation Program (UTP)

The Texas Department of Transportation, working through the Texas Transportation Commission, develops a 10-year listing of major transportation projects within the State of Texas. A status report on projects in the Dallas-Fort Worth region will be posted.

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Stormwater Project

Efforts are underway to develop a new program aimed at preventing the impacts of stormwater in flood prone areas within the Dallas-Fort Worth region. Federal, State, regional, and local organizations are working together on how the region could become a national leader in reducing loss of life and financial impacts of major flooding events. Details of this proposed project will be posted.
